This notice is an invitation to attend a public meeting to discuss proposed new, amended and elimination of existing fees to the Stanislaus County Master Schedule of Fees for the Department of Parks & Recreation. Stanislaus County Parks and Recreation's mission is "*We build community by enriching lives through outdoor experiences that inspire lifetimes.*" Parks and Recreation recognizes that the collaboration and input of the community is valuable to ensure we accomplish this goal.

You are invited to join our staff to discuss the proposed adjustments to the fee schedule. The department will address the basis for the proposed changes and there will be an opportunity to ask questions. This includes new, amended and elimination of existing fees related to:

- Exclusive Use and Picnic Shelters
- Reservoir Camping
- Waterfowl Permit and Registration

This workshop is being conducted prior to the Board of Supervisors' approval of the fee proposals. If the fees are approved, they will become effective by Dec 28, 2023.
